ORAL EXAMINATION

The oral examination shall be a computer based examination of multiple choice questions carried out by the licensing officer to test the knowledge of an applicant for a driving licence on the following topics —

- (a) road traffic rules for drivers, two-wheelers and pedestrians;
 (b) road traffic signs, including regulatory signs, warning signs, prohibitory signs, mandatory signs and information signs;
 (c) road markings, including transverse and longitudinal markings;
 (d) traffic signals and hand signals of police officers;
 - (e) driving in adverse weather conditions;
 - (f) the cumulative road traffic offences;
 - (g) offences related to driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
 - (h) vehicle and tyre maintenance;
 - (i) consequences of speeding, reaction times and vehicle stopping distance;
 - (j) circumstances in which a person shall not drive (distractions, fatigue, alcohol and drugs).
